Vinification	In closed fermentation tanks. Fermentation was interrupted through the addition of grape brandy in order to preserve a degree of natural sweetness.								
Maturing and bottling	In Wiese & Krohn's cellars in Vila Nova de Gaia, on the Atlantic coast, under the control of the Douro and Portwine Institute.
